Pursuant to Article VI, § 2 of the LADC Bylaws, as amended in 2005, LADC members may vote for directors to fill the eleven (11) vacant slots on the LADC Board of Directors. The vacancies are not the usual eleven. In District 5 none are to be elected this year because one director resigned in 2008 after election to judicial office, and thus two directors were elected in District 5 in 2009. In District 6 three are to be elected this year because one director discontinued practicing law.

Below are two lists. The first list indicates the candidates nominated by the Nominating Committee to fill the 11 upcoming vacancies. These nominees have been nominated to replace the current directors who are "completing" their two-year terms this year. The second list is of all current directors, by district, and designates who will be "completing" their term and who will be "continuing" their term.

As an LADC member, you may cast a vote for each of the 11 vacant director slots, not just your own district. You may vote for any or all of the candidates nominated by the Nominating Committee or you may write in candidates in the space provided. You are not restricted to voting for your district.
